

Letting Student View Group Members

A common question from instructors using the groups feature is: "How can I let students know who else is in their group?"

To let students see which classmates are in their groups:

1. Log into Moodle and go to your course.

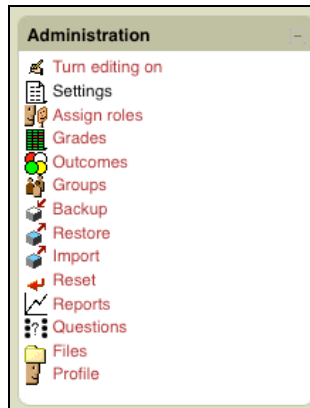


Figure 1: Settings Link.

2. Click the "Settings" link under the administration block (see figure 1).

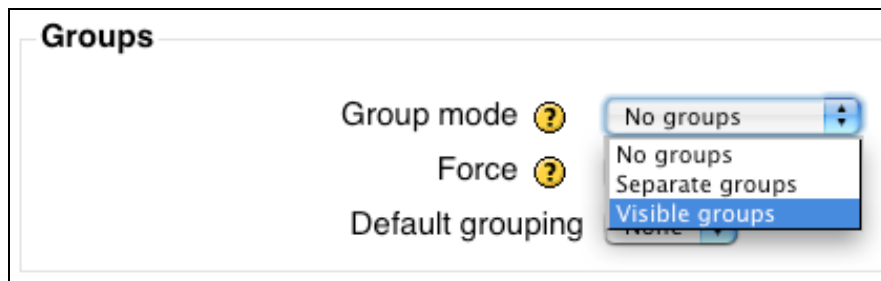


Figure 2: Groups options.

3. Locate the "Group mode" option under the "Groups" section (see figure 2).

4. If you want students to be able to view their group's members as well as the other groups select the "Visible Groups" option from the "Group mode" drop down menu.
5. If you do not want students to be able to see other groups or group members select "Separate groups" from the "Group mode" drop down menu.
6. Scroll down and click "Save Changes."

- When a student logs into Moodle he/she can click on the "Participants" link, under the "People" block, and see what group they are in. The other groups in the course will also be visible (unless "Separate groups" is selected in step 4) as well as all of the course participants (see figure 3).
