

1.1) The Protocols which are used from the data link layer to the presentation layers are:
FTP, TCP, ARP, Ethernet.
1.2) Application Layer: FTP- it accesses a database to convert the host name to the ip address.
Say my.njit.edu to a address 192.168.101.11
Transport layer: TCP- FTP program calls a TCP protocol to establish connection to the machine with the address of the destination of njit server 192.168.101.11
Now the TCP uses the 3-way handshake mechanism to establish connection with the destination server. The home laptop finds out if the destination server is at the same Ethernet by sending a broadcast frame to the local router X
Network Layer: ARP- Arp translates the IP address 192.168.101.11 to a Ethernet Address using address resolution protocol i.e. 128.235.101.23 to 0:0:E:9:2d:c
Data Link Layer: Ethernet- it encapsulates the IP datagrams to Ethernet frames
